## Annual Report, June 2007 - June 2008

### GOALS:

At the SLECT meeting on July 14, 2007, the committee determined its annual goals. As with any business or organization, it is important to set goals and measure ourselves. These goals were classified into the categories Political, Financial, and Organizational. For each goal there was a designated leader assigned to take responsibility for achieving the goal. Below are the results:

### POLITICAL GOALS:

- (1) GOAL: 250 candidates on the ballot at the close of the 2008 State convention  
LEADER: Wes Benedict  
RESULT: UNSUCCESSFUL – We had 173 candidates on the ballot at the convention. This was an alltime record for the Libertarian Party of Texas. The Ron Paul campaign did impact us as many potential candidates voted in the Republican primary and were excluded by state law from being a Libertarian Party candidate.
- (2) GOAL: Recruit candidates to contest a majority of state house and senate seats  
LEADER: Wes Benedict  
RESULT: ACHEIVED – The more candidates we have in the state legislative races, the greater ability we have to influence policy. We exceeded our goal, but we want to fill every race.

### FINANCIAL GOALS:

- (1) GOAL: Increase the recurring gift amount to \$5,500/month  
LEADER: Wes Benedict



RESULT: UNSUCCESSFUL – Our recurring gifts as of June 30, 2008 are \$3982.67.

- (2) GOAL: Maintain reserve of \$12,000  
LEADER: Mike Burris  
RESULT: ACHIEVED – We finished the period of June 30, 2008 with a reserve of \$18,648.63
- (3) GOAL: Increase donor base to 1,000 (in prior 12 month period).  
LEADER: Wes Benedict  
RESULT: UNSUCCESSFUL – We finished the term with 779 donors
- (4) GOAL: Add 5 new platinum members  
LEADER: Wes Benedict  
RESULT: ACHEIVED – We had exactly 5 platinum members at June 30, 2008

#### ORGANIZATIONAL GOALS:

- (1) GOAL: One or more counties with bylaws and a standing Executive Committee in each state senate district  
LEADER: James Gholston  
RESULT: UNSUCCESSFUL – The state party is not aware of bylaws and executive committees in each district.
- (2) GOAL: Establish state LP campus committee which will organize 3 events on college campus  
LEADER: Candace Sessums  
RESULT: UNSUCCESSFUL – No campus committee was formed
- (3) GOAL: State party resumes sending communication to Lone Star Liberty subscribers at least once a month  
LEADER: Pat Dixon  
RESULT: ACHEIVED – The Lone Star Liberty newsletter now has almost 2000 subscribers and is sent every month.

In conclusion, we have met 1 of our 2 political goals, 2 of our 4 financial goals, and 1 of our 3 organizational goals.
